8. Ed. Prog. GT – Acceptable (currently testing students for G/T placement, teacher training, professional development geared to GT students and programs)
9. Reporting – Good (Recent changes in attendance recording improved, the campus has never been cited or dinged for missing reporting deadlines in other reporting areas, etc., participation and results on Fitnessgram, Office of Civil Rights compliance, Campus Plan/District Plan)
