PLEASE NOTE.....Microsoft teams is accessible through your cell phone and the app is FREE. Class sessions will be recorded so you may view at your convenience-BUT WORK MUST BE TURNED IN BY 10:59P.M. TO RECEIVE CREDIT FOR THE DAY.

IN ORDER FOR YOUR CHILD TO BE COUNTED PRESENT-STUDENTS MUST MAKE CONTACT WITH THEIR TEACHER/LOG ONTO MICROSOFT TEAMS ON A DAILY BASIS. This can be done by taking a picture of the assignment with your cell phone and sending it to their teacher.

- You MUST Log on to Microsoft teams on a daily basis
- Click on TEAM Tab to find class/subject
- Click on the Whiteboard in the virtual classroom*
- Click on question (s)
- Answer question(s)
- This will be immediately sent to the attendance clerk
- **These instructions may be different according to grade level. Classroom teacher will provide additional instructions on the first virtual class day.

Daily work must be completed and submitted on a daily basis in order to receive grade and attendance credit.

You may take a picture of completed assignment and send it to teacher through Microsoft TEAMS

Packet Pick Up Days-for students who do not have access to electronic devices:
Thursday, August 13/pick up at meet the teacher (6 days of instruction)
Tuesday, August 25/pick up from 3:00-5:00 (7 days of instruction)
