PROM GUIDELINES

The Junior-Senior Promenade is a formal school event sponsored by the Junior Class in honor of the graduating class and will be held on Saturday, May 19th. It will be governed according to the rules and regulations that have been established by the Agua Dulce Independent School District.

The Junior-Senior Promenade is a **PRIVILEGE** and not a **RIGHT**. All students and guests that attend Agua Dulce High School's Prom must be properly dressed. The Prom is a formal affair where formal attire is expected. Formal attire is clothing that is worn to formal occasions in the evening. This consists of clothing of a distinctive style that is designed specifically for a special occasion. Attendees will be expected to dress and behave in a dignified manner.

To help students understand what is expected of them, we're providing the following guidelines:

GENERAL RULES

1. Students must be listed as a junior or as a senior, and they may invite one high school student (9-12) or guest who is no older than 20 years old.
2. Students will not be allowed to make adjustments to clothing; i.e., use safety pins to pin up a slit or gaping necklines, put on her guest's jacket, etc.
3. Females are not permitted to wear the jacket that belongs to her date to camouflage inappropriate attire.
4. Any student who chooses not to abide by the Prom Guidelines *will not be admitted—even just to take pictures.*

GENTLEMEN

Tuxedos with bowtie, neckties, dress shirts, dress slacks, and dress shoes are permitted.

YOUNG LADIES CANNOT WEAR

- Sheer fabric that reveals body parts.
- Navels (belly buttons) and cleavage should not be exposed.
- Slits in dresses/skirts that extend two (3) or more inches above the kneecaps, bikini tops, diamond bras, or bras worn as shirts
- Backdrop dresses that drop extremely low.
- Plunging necklines.

INVITED GUESTS

1. The guest must be in high school (9-12th). OR
2. The invited guest must be no more than 20 years of age.
3. All off campus guests **MUST BE** approved by Dr. Daniels.
4. All guests must follow the rules and regulations. **It is your responsibility to make certain that your guest is apprised of these rules.**

ADMISSION TO THE PROM

The Prom will begin at 8:00 p.m., and end at 12 midnight. No one will be admitted after 10:00 p.m.

- Students will not be allowed to leave the ballroom to retrieve forgotten items or put items inside of the car. If students decide to leave, they will not be allowed back into Prom under any circumstances. All other students will not be permitted to leave the ballroom until 12 midnight.

Sign Up Sheet

- Students and invited guests need to sign up in the front office and show ID. All guests are expected to show ID at the door of Prom.
